Trade Demand Index


We're seeing more tradies opting to establish their own businesses and work independently; a trend accelerated by the decrease in building consents and larger companies getting light on major developments.

Talking demand, we've seen an increase in the number of homeowners signing up and posting jobs in January 2024, compared to January 2023. A 2% increase in signups and a 6% increase in jobs show that homeowners were keen to kick-start new projects after the holidays. These insights suggest a resilience in job opportunities despite the challenges facing the trades industry.

Our Trade Demand Index aggregates a variety of Builderscrack data-points into a representative measure of demand on the trades sector.



With warmer weather and faster turnaround times, exterior Painting & Decorating was a popular choice for homeowners over summer.


